3. Webinar on Cancer Awareness




The Webinar was mainly aimed to give a general awareness on various types of cancers especially affecting women. They mainly focused on the breast cancer,

During the interactive session that followed teachers, students and parents asked their doubts. The programme was very useful for all the participants.






4. Women's Day Celebration

A speech contest was conducted in association with PG department of English and a Flash mob was performed by First Year Degree students.








5. Webinar on CYBER CRIMES
