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


ONE DAY SEMINAR ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

WEBINAR ON 'MAHAMARI KALATHE VAYANA'






INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR ON LEADING INNOVATIONS: A PROMISE TO PROGRESS


NATIONAL WEBINAR ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS


ONLINE LECTURE SERIES ON "CULTURAL STUDIES"


WEBINAR ON PIRACY IN MALABAR

LECTURE ON EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND IPR



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


BLOCK CHAIN TECHNOLOGY- WHAT IT IS AND WHY IT MATTERS WEBINAR




TWO DAYS NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON INTERNET OF THINGS





NATIONAL WEBINAR ON MACHINE LEARNING AND ITS APPLICATONS




RESEARCH METHODLOGY IN COMUTER SCIENE


HIGH PERFORMANCE COMPUTERS: CHALLENGES FOR WEATHER AND CLIMATE



COMMUNICATION SKILL THROUGH LANGUAGE LAB TRAINING



LIFE SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME LIFE SKILLS FOR WOMEN EMPOWERMENT




ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON CREATIVE WRITING


IGNITE 2021-22 - Faculty Development Programme for Teaching Staff


FDP on Stress and Time Management




CURRENT STATUS OF THE ELAVU PROJECT




WASTE MANAGEMENT
